☆ St Thomas More's Dying Words

None of the saints achieved their holiness and happiness without suffering, because only through suffering for and with Christ could their love for Christ mature. The last words of St Thomas More sum up the lesson beautifully. St Thomas More was the Chancellor of England in the early 1500s, a layman, and a close friend and faithful servant of King Henry VIII. Unfortunately, the King was less faithful. When his first wife didn't give him a son, and one of the ladies in waiting seduced him, King Henry requested an annulment from the Pope. But there were no grounds for an annulment. So King Henry, instead of humbly accepting the Church's decision and trusting in God, took things into his own hands. He declared himself the supreme head of the Church in England, denouncing the Pope's rightful supremacy. Then with his newfound religious authority, he granted himself the annulment, so he could marry his mistress. Almost all of England's bishops and noblemen took the king's side in this affair, and the Anglican Church was born. St Thomas More, the King's highest ranking adviser, refused to sign the Act of Supremacy and go along with the King. He and his family were threatened, cajoled, and tortured, but he would not betray Christ's Church. Finally, he was convicted of treason and executed. There are various accounts of his last words. In the 1966 Academy Award winning movie that tells his life story, his last words are recorded as: "I die the King's good servant, but God's first." In this fallen world, to love Christ with all our heart, soul, mind and strength, will get us into trouble, sooner or later. But that kind of trouble is good for our souls, which is why God allows it. Suffering for Christ matures our love, and only mature love gives lasting meaning to our lives.

Eucharistic Revival this Easter - Love and Sacrifice belong Together.

"Our love of comfort eliminates sacrifice from our lives, and there is no love without sacrifice, so our obsession with comfort is eliminating love. In a world that can be cold and harsh, violent and at times brutal, the saints prove that our humanity has a better side. Our better side is kind and caring, compassionate, and gentle. The saints fostered this better side with spiritual disciplines and acts of loving service. These acts required personal sacrifices that can be directly linked to the Cross via the Eucharist... Our modern times seem addicted to comfort and allergic to sacrifice. Both postures make the Christian life at least difficult and at most impossible. In order to love, and love deeply, we have to be willing to give up some comfort and take on some sacrifice. Love of comfort is a form of self-worship. Let us set aside our fixation with comfort and worship the one true God by adopting the spirit of sacrifice that Jesus embraced on the Cross. Our willingness to make sacrifices for those we love is one of the ways we give weight to the words, "I love you." And where does the courage, strength, and grace to make life-giving sacrifices come from? From Jesus in the Eucharist. Saint Maximilian Kolbe wrote, "Jesus, You come to me and unite Yourself intimately to me in the form of nourishment. Your Blood now runs in mine, Your Soul, Incarnate God, penetrates mine, giving courage and support. What miracles! Who would have ever imagined such!" [Matthew Kelly]

Old truth, new insight: "Infinite Dignity" - Just Released.

Cardinal Víctor Manuel Fernández, prefect of the doctrinal dicastery, presented the declaration, "Dignitas Infinita" ("Infinite Dignity"), at a Vatican news conference April 8. Pointing to all the footnotes, a journalist asked the cardinal why the document was necessary since it seemed to be just a list of things that had already been said about human dignity and the sacredness of human life and against abortion, surrogacy and sex-change surgery. The declaration, he responded, summarises "the most important teachings about human dignity and organises them around a central point, which is the dignity of every human being 'beyond all circumstances,'" an affirmation from Pope Francis' encyclical "Fratelli Tutti, on Fraternity and Social Friendship." "Dignitas Infinita" reiterates and strengthens the Church's perennial teaching on the universal and infinite dignity of every human person, emphasising its origin in God, the loving creator who formed us in His own image. In light of this, the new Document condemns the grave violations of human dignity that arise in today's world from a number of contemporary evils including: violence against women, abortion, surrogacy, euthanasia, gender theory, sex change operations, and digital violence.
