Easter Faith: Letter to an Unborn Child

"I just want to tell you that life is a wonderful thing, and the world is really full of remarkable people." So starts a letter written by one of the survivors of the bomb attacks at the Brussels Zaventem international airport. The author of the letter, Sneha Mehta, penned those words to her child, who was only 16 weeks old in utero. When Sneha and her husband, Sameep Mehta, arrived in Brussels from Abu Dhabi last Tuesday, they were abruptly greeted with screams and chaos, as the ceiling of the airport started to collapse. The couple was faced with the split-second decision to either remain in the shambles of the arrival section, or try to leave for the hospital to check on their baby. "I absolutely didn't know which direction to run in." Amidst all the uncertainty, Sneha said that she knew one thing "for sure": She would survive for the sake of their unborn baby. The Mehtas fled the airport and ran straight to the highway, where a cab driver stopped to take them to Sint Augustinus hospital. Despite the traumatic chaos of the day, the ultrasound exam showed the Mehtas' baby peacefully sucking its thumb, unaware of the terror happening outside the womb. Unlike many memories from that day, Sneha recalled not the hatred and violence that broke loose upon the city, but the kindness she encountered from complete strangers. She remembered the police and rescue crews who were quick to aid the wounded. She recalled the cab driver who not only brought them to the hospital, but talked to them the whole way there. Now that she is a survivor, and safely back home in Antwerp, Sneha decided to write a letter to her unborn baby as a reminder of all that had happened — to be opened with the child older. The letter reads: Hi Sweetheart, I don't know if we already acknowledged this with you in person, but when you were 16 weeks old, mum and dad were in an explosion at Brussels Airport. And no matter where humanity is today, I just want to tell you that life is a wonderful thing, and the world is really full of remarkable people. You didn't just give mum and dad faith and reason to live, you gave the awareness and presence of mind like never before. I felt more alive than I ever have, and I knew I had to protect you, so I was calm, composed and fully aware that we will survive. When we reached Sint-Augustinus emergency, and we saw you oblivious and sucking at your thumb at the ultrasound, and doing your general acrobatics, all the mistrust, hate and angst for the terrorist attack vaporised. I do hope with all my heart that you are born into a better world, and if not, then you do absolute best to make it that. You are absolutely precious to us and have already been a hero today. I guess [because] the world has sent so much



love and hope your way, you owe your life to reciprocating that goodness. May you always be brave and healthy. We love you beyond words, Mum and Dad. Sneha might give the sealed letter to their child at age 16, or they may wait until a later time. Either way, Sneha wants her child to know that love is victorious over hatred.

"With every little "yes" we give God, our spiritual senses will be awakened, restored, sharpened, strengthened. Say "yes" to God today in as many little ways possible. This way you will be ready when a big "yes" is required of you. How will you do it? By realizing where the strength comes from. Can you do it by yourself? No. But you can do it. Remind yourself: "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." (Philippians 4:13) Saint Irenaeus observed, "The glory of God is man fully alive." What would your life look like if you were "fully alive?" What would have to be true for you to become fully alive? God is calling you to wholeness and holiness. Consider the four aspects of the human person: physical, emotional, intellectual, and spiritual. In which of these areas are you thriving? In which are you just surviving? 

Stay in the Shepherd's Hand

Jesus said that no one can snatch us out of his hand. But we are free to jump out of his hand. Little by little we can drift away from Him. The cares and concerns of everyday life can get to us. We can get tired, and forget why we do what we do. Socrates famously said that the unexamined life is not worth living. The Church has taken this universal wisdom and frequently proposed a daily examination of conscience to help us remain in the hands of Christ. In fact St Ignatius Loyola told the early Jesuits that even if they omitted all other daily prayer, they must not drop the daily examination of conscience. So here's the take-away from this Mass. Each day this week, let's commit to 10 minute conscience exam. Here's how. First of all, I remind myself that I'm in the presence of God. I am His temple. Second, I give thanks to God. I pick a few things from my day that I'm especially grateful for: my family, the weather, the food I've eaten, the football game... Third, I prayerfully review my thoughts and actions from the day. Where was God trying to lead me? How did I respond? Fourth I ask forgiveness for any sins I've committed. Fifth, I ask for God's help



to grow in his friendship. The examination of conscience is one of the best ways to stay in Christ's hand, and experience the joy that he promises us. How to be prepare to receive communion? In the Mass we receive Jesus Christ. We receive his presence and his promise and his joy that no one can ever take away from us. And we know that even as we receive him now, in the Eucharist, someday we're going to see him face to face forever in heaven.


